A local law to change a single elected assessor.

as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 329 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the number of elected assessors in the Town of Sangerfield, Oneida County, New York shall be reduced from three to one. The terms of all elected assessors presently in office shall terminate December 31, 1999. One assessor shall be elected at the November 2, 1999 general election to serve a six-year term commencing January 1, 2000.

2. This local law shall take effect immediately under filing with the Secretary of State.
